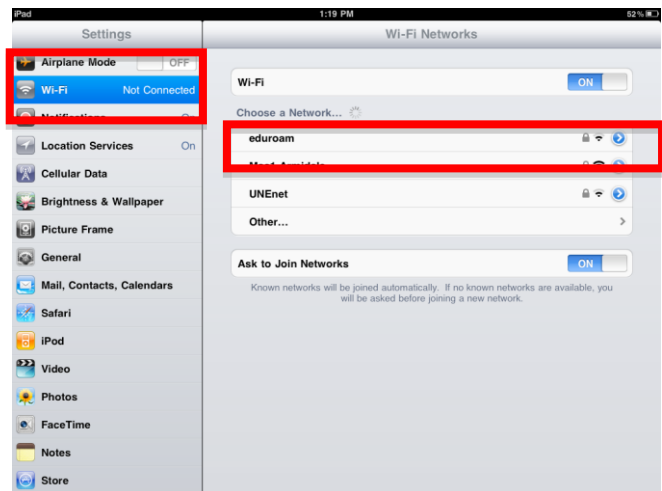

What is eduroam? eduroam (**education roaming**) is the secure, world-wide roaming access service developed for the international research and education community. eduroam allows students, researchers and staff from participating institutions to obtain Internet connectivity across campus and when visiting other participating institutions without additional setup.

Use the instructions below to connect to the UNE eduroam network. Once set up, you will be able to access eduroam wireless networks at other participating universities.

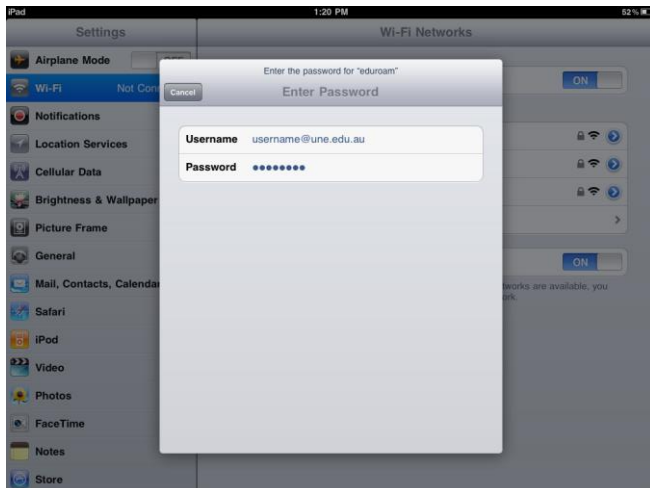
1. Tap the **“Settings”** icon on your home screen.
2. Tap the **Wi-Fi** line.
3. Select **“eduroam”** from the list of available wireless networks
